

## **Potential Discussion Questions**

### **Message: Know God - Just (6-10-18)**

1. Share a situation where you experienced justice? injustice? Why was injustice difficult?
2. How would you define or describe justice? What biblical truths and characteristics of God most closely intertwine with God's justice? What scriptures reveal these connections?
3. Read over a number of passages that focus on God's justice. What do you find that supports the content of the message? What additional insights do you gain?
4. How would you explain the necessity of dealing with sin in the context of God's justice?
5. Why can God be fair when He overlooks offenses, at least for a season, and pronounces guilty people not guilty? (see Romans 3. What other passages help you with this?)
6. How does the Gospel of Jesus directly impact our understanding of justice? (How do grace and mercy connect with justice?)
7. Sometimes people complain that God is not always fair. Have you ever felt that? Why?
8. What, in your experience or observation, is at the heart of accusations that God is not always fair? How might you respond?
9. What is the significance to you that God is a perfect judge of the universe?
10. What did you gain from the illustrations of the punching teen and the % of evil God should allow in heaven?
11. What else would you like to discuss about this study on God's justice?
12. What is your best take-away from this study?
13. Are you currently dealing with some injustice about which the group could pray for you?
